Show Announcements



Barns do not open until NOON on Friday, 10/27. Do not arrive prior to NOON, as you will not be permitted to unload horses, decorate stalls or check-in. No exceptions.

Friday, 10/27 Check-in begins Noon – Closes 9 PM Only Rimrock Avenue Entrance will be open

In accordance with the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (ATCP 10.87).

1. Upon arrival, all participants will enter the RIMROCK AVENUE MAIN GATE and proceed to the Coggins Check-in. Staff will direct you to check-in once you enter the RIMROCK gate. Have a copy of the Coggins ready for each horse in your trailer. Staff at the Coggins Check-In will provide you with your stall assignment and stall card.

Note: Horses will not be permitted to off-load unless they have a current negative Coggins and the horse identified matches the horse shown at the District show.

2. All participants arriving on Saturday will need to report to the WIHA Show Office before off-loading their horse(s), located in the Pavilion #2 - a WIHA Board of Director will return with you to your trailer - to complete the Coggins Check-in and provide you with the proper paperwork.
3. Lodi Veterinary Care will be conducting daily walk-throughs of the horse barns.

All dogs on show grounds – must be on a leash.

No Golf Carts or UTVs on show grounds.

Rules of the Alliant Energy Center (AEC). Violators will be fined:

1. Painting of hooves is prohibited on any concrete surface inside the Pavilions and under the overhangs. Painting is allowed on the blacktop surfaces outside the buildings with the use of a board, rubber mat, feed bag, etc. under the hooves.
2. Affixing any materials to the walls or décor of any stalls with tape, screws, nails, glue, staples, or adhesive is prohibited. Zip-ties and string are permitted.
3. No carry-ins are allowed - this includes crockpots, coffeemakers, etc.
4. Camping is available on a first-come, first-serve basis at the self-serve kiosk.
